This study examines the transnational migration of Korean-Chinese individuals from Northeastern China, focusing on their engagement in Bottari Jangsa, a form of small-scale migrant trade, in Russia since the 1990s. Following China's economic reforms, which revitalized private commerce and expanded the urban service sector, internal migration increased nationwide. However, Korean-Chinese women displayed particularly high mobility, relocating to urban centers and also across borders to North Korea and Russia. Senior members of the Koryo-saram community communicated with these migrants in Korean, and this shared ethnolinguistic identity facilitated the formation of Sino-Russian trade networks. The drivers of Korean-Chinese migration to Russia reflect earlier patterns of Bottari Jangsa observed along the Sino-North Korean border. (1) the dissolution of the People's Commune system and the accompanying reduction of women's public roles amid economic restructuring and (2) the expansion of economic activity driven by a sense of personal insecurity in the face of rapid social transformation.
